BYLAW NO. 5349

A bylaw of the Cariboo Regional District, in the Province of British Columbia, to amend the Miocene Fire Protection Service boundaries.

WHEREAS a local service area has been established by the Cariboo Regional District by Bylaw No. 2809, cited as "Miocene Fire Protection Local Service Establishment Bylaw No. 2809, 1993", and amendments thereto; and

WHEREAS pursuant to the provisions of the *Local Government Act,* being Chapter 323 of the Revised Statutes of British Columbia, and amendments thereto, a Board may, by bylaw, amend establishment bylaws, and

WHEREAS the Board of Directors of the Cariboo Regional District has been petitioned by a property owner who wishes to be part of the Miocene Fire Protection Service Area; and,

WHEREAS the Board has deemed it in the interest of providing good government to expand the boundaries of the Miocene Fire Protection Service Area to include the subject property; and

NOW THEREFORE the Board of Directors of the Cariboo Regional District, duly assembled, hereby enacts as follows:

1. Title

This bylaw may be cited for all purposes as "Miocene Fire Protection Service Boundary Amendment Bylaw No. 5349, 2021".

2. Amendment

Schedule A, as referred to in Section 1 of Bylaw No. 2809, is deleted and replaced by Schedule A attached to and forming part of this bylaw.
