
### **Priority Investment**

### Mills Memorial Hospital Redevelopment Project

- The total capital cost of the Project is \$622.6 million with Northwest Regional Hospital District (NWRHD) funding of \$110.2 million.
- The construction is in the first phase and is scheduled to be complete in 2024 with work on the second phase (demolition and paving of the old hospital) expected to start once the new Hospital and new Seven Sisters are fully operational.
- The completion of the entire Project is expected in 2026.
- The Design Build model was selected for the Project as it is expected to best meet Northern Health's procurement and overall Project objectives and allow Northern Health to best manage and mitigate key project risks to deliver the Project in a cost effective and efficient manner.

### Mills Memorial Hospital Redevelopment Project

- Steering Committee started in 2019 after business plan approval.
   Includes representation from North West RHD. Meets monthly.
- Capital Project Advisory Committee started in 2018. Includes representatives from Northern Health, local First Nations, municipalities and partners. Meets quarterly.
- MMH Indigenous Working Group started in spring 2021. Includes representatives from local First Nations, Métis Nation and Indigenous groups. Meets every 2-3 months or as needed.
- MMH Community Advisory Working Group Started September 2021.
   Representatives from regional and community organizations. To meet every 2-3 months or as needed.





### Priority Investment Fort St James Stuart Lake Hospital Redevelopment

- Government approved the business plan on January 18, 2020.
- Request for Qualifications (RFQ) Stage was completed July 2020.
- Request for Proposals (RFP) Design Early Works Agreement (DEWA)
   Stage was August 2020 to June 2021.
- RFP Design Build Agreement Stage was submitted to Graham Construction February 2021.
  - Currently at 30% design development, progressing towards the 60% submission December 2021.

Current schedule has Construction is tentatively planned to begin June

2022.

# Priority Investment Dawson Creek & District Hospital Redevelopment

- Government approved the business plan on September 4, 2020.
- Capital Planning is working closely with Infrastructure BC in this development.
- Proceeding with Progressive Design Build procurement.
- A Request for Proposals (RFP) was issued to three shortlisted proponents resulting in Clark Turner Dawson Creek JV signing the Design Early Works Agreement on September 2, 2021. The Design-Build Agreement RFP was issued September 8, 2021.
- The Capital Project Advisory Committee continues to meet on a quarterly basis. The intent is to keep the community and local First Nations informed of the project and receive input.





#### Dawson Creek & District Hospital Replacement Project Dawson Creek, BC

### **Priority Investment**

#### Quesnel: GR Baker ED+ICU Addition

- The project was announced on April 2019.
- Regional cultural history and finding human remains at the site necessitates continuous archaeological review until all excavation at the site is complete.
- The Early Works phase, completed in March 2020, revealed further human remains. The remains were confirmed to be of First Nations descent and were reinterred during a traditional ceremony on November 30, 2020.
- The project tendered successfully within approved funding and was awarded for construction in August 2020.
- Construction is proceeding under COVID-19 protocols and the project is scheduled to be complete in the Summer of 2022.

  - Cost escalation on components due to global supply chain challenges
  - Availability of experienced contractors bidding on projects
  - Availability of materials and supplies

### Sterile Compounding Room Upgrades

### **Bulkley Valley District Hospital**

- Project Value \$2,505,000
- Northwest RHD Funding \$1,002,000
- Renovate the existing space next to the Pharmacy to add a hazardous compounding and ante room, Hazardous drug storage, and preparation space to meet NAPRA (National Association of Pharmacy Regulatory Authorities) Standards.
- Project Status: Awaiting approval of by-law exception from Town of Smithers.

### Fort St John Hospital

- Project Value \$1,006,500
- Peace River RHD Funding \$402,600
- Renovate the existing Pharmacy sterile prep space and ante room, hazardous compounding and ante room, Hazardous drug storage, and non sterile preparation space to meet NAPRA Standards
- Project Status: Started construction October 2021; estimated completion January 2022.

### Sterile Compounding Room Upgrades

### **Prince Rupert Hospital**

- Project Value \$1,540,000
- Northwest RHD Funding \$616,000
- Renovate the existing Pharmacy sterile prep space and ante room, hazardous compounding and ante room, Hazardous drug storage, and non sterile preparation space to meet NAPRA Standards.
- Project Status: Design Stage Reviewing options for new Air Handling Unit placement

### St John Hospital (Vanderhoof)

- Project Value \$1,972,000
- Stuart Nechako RHD Funding \$788,800
- Renovate the existing Pharmacy hazardous compounding and ante room, Hazardous drug storage, and non sterile preparation space to meet NAPRA Standards.
- Project Status: In Construction 75% complete



### Sterile Compounding Room Upgrades

#### **UHNBC**

- Project Value \$1,900,000
- Fraser Fort George RHD Funding \$760,000
- Design and planning for renovating the existing Pharmacy sterile prep space and ante room, hazardous compounding and ante room, Hazardous drug storage, and non sterile preparation space to meet NAPRA Standards.
- Project Status: Design Phase Early Design being completed with emphasis on Air Handling Unit requirements and location.



### **Bulkley Lodge Nurse Call System**

- Project Value: \$429,000
- Northwest RHD Funding: \$171,600
- Project Description: Replacement of failing nurse call system.
- Project Status: Final design is ongoing, with tender expected within the next couple weeks. Construction is expected to be completed by March 2022.



#### Fort St John Lab Renovation

- Project Value: \$1,217,000
- Peace River RHD Funding: \$486,800
- Project Description: WorkSafe BC Compliance
- Project Status: Started Construction October 2021; estimated completion January 2022



#### **GR Baker Kitchen Renovations**

- Project Value: \$5,000,000
- Cariboo Chilcotin RHD Funding: \$2,000,000
- Project Description: Renovate the existing Medical Records storage space to the new kitchen. Demolition of the existing kitchen space.
- Project Status: Construction on new kitchen completed August 30, 2021. Demolition of old Kitchen to be completed by November 30, 2021.



### **Gateway Lodge Vocera**

- Project Value: \$497,000
- Fraser Fort George RHD Funding: \$198,800
- Project Description: Vocera System enables instant hands-free communication between staff members and departments. The system uses wireless technology to provide mobile staff members with instant voice communication.
- Project Status: In progress. Vendor confirming scope and pricing and then set up of the integration for Nurse calls to flow into Connexall (equipment to be shipped to the site).



#### Northern Haida Gwaii Observation Room

- Project Value: \$991,000
- Northwest RHD Funding: \$396,400
- Description: The Psychiatric Observation Room was approved to proceed in fiscal year 2019/20. COVID-19 prevented further design development.
- Next Steps:
  - Update tender drawings.
  - Tender and award construction.
  - Commission & use.
- Approximate completion Summer 2022.





### Quesnel Mental Health Substance Abuse Club Leasehold Improvement

- Project Value: \$1,271,000
- Cariboo Chilcotin RHD Funding: \$508,400
- Project Description: Increased program space needs related to expansion of programming and implementation of Overdose Prevention Site in Quesnel.
- Project Status: In Design Development.



# Terrace Specialist Clinic Leasehold Improvement

- Project Value: \$1,749,000
- Northwest RHD Funding: \$699,600
- Project Description: Relocation of the Pediatric specialist clinic in Terrace. The Mills Memorial Hospital replacement project will see this clinic space removed from the site during the early construction period.
- Project Status: In Design Development.



### **Tumbler Ridge Cooling System Replacement**

- Project Value: \$598,000
- Peace River RHD Funding: \$239,200
- Project Description: Complete removal of existing cooling systems (Roof top Condensing Unit and evaporator coil within the Air Handling Unit) and replacement with new.
- Project Status: Initial structural work and shipment of major equipment is expected mid-October. Installation of some equipment will be as weather permits. Full install and commissioning will occur in Spring 2022.



# UHNBC Cardiac Services Department Renovations

- Project Value: \$12,500,000
- Fraser Fort George RHD Funding: \$5,000,000
- Capital Planning worked with UHNBC to confirm the proposed location within the hospital. The project to be completed in three phases to accommodate the renovations and moves required to ensure no loss of service for each department.
- Project Status: Awaiting approval from Ministry for business plan. Phase One Tender to follow immediately after approval.

### **UHNBC** Transformer Replacement

- Project Value: \$2,125,000
- Fraser Fort George RHD Funding: \$850,000
- Project Description: Replace existing transformers to provide adequate capacity and system redundancy.
- Project Status: Design is ongoing, with tender expected in October. Construction will occur in the existing powerhouse, and switch over to the new system is anticipated in March 2022. Construction is scheduled to be complete in May 2022.

# Bulkley Lodge Domestic Hot Water Heaters, Tank and Re-piping

- Project Value: \$546,667
- Northwest RHD Funding: \$100,055
- Product Description: Two new heating boilers and new high efficiency hot water tank or heat exchangers interfaced with the new boilers.
- Project Status: Budget increased to complete all work as one phase (initially the work would have occurred over two fiscal years). Substantial completion projected for October 15, 2021.



### **Dunrovin Lodge Heating Boilers Replacement**

- Project Value: \$631,948
- Cariboo Chilcotin RHD Funding: \$252,779
- Product Description: Replace old atmospheric boilers with high efficiency condensing boilers and upgrade Domestic Hot Water (DHW) system with tankless boilers.
- Project Status: Demolition and construction under way with proposed commissioning November 2021.



### Fort Nelson Boiler Upgrade and Heat Recovery

- Project Value: \$743,598
- Northern Rockies RHD Funding: \$297,439
- Product Description: Upgrade old boilers to high efficiency and repipe/reconfigure for more efficient operation. Provide heat recovery for the air handling unit and heating ventilation that is connected to exhaust fans.
- Project Status: Demolition and construction underway with commissioning set for November 2021.



### Houston Air Handling Unit (AHU) Replacement

- Project Value: \$866,715
- Northwest RHD Funding: \$346,686
- Product Description: Replace existing air handling unit and cooling/condensing unit
- Project Status: Construction contract awarded, equipment on order with delivery to site mid-January 2022. Phased installation with the air handling unit. Estimated completion May 2022.



### Prince Rupert Domestic Hot Water Upgrade

- Project Value: \$478,998
- Northwest RHD Funding: \$191,600
- Product Description: Incorporate dedicated Domestic Hot Water (DHW) heaters, piping upgrades, and decoupling of the high temperature system from the general system to allow the general DHW system to run at lower temperatures and more efficiently.
- Project Status: Currently in design phase to tender December 2021. Construction should complete by February 2022.

#### **Endoscopy System Phase 1**

#### Northern Lights - Personal Health Record/Portal

- Project Value: \$1,197,000
- RHD Funding: \$478,800
- Description: The Northern Lights Project involves the establishment of two patient portals linked to primary and community care, and acute care Electronic Medical Records (EMR) to provide lab results and imaging reports to people receiving care within Northern Health.
