Short Summary:

Cariboo Regional District Procedure Bylaw No. 5350, 2021

Memorandum:

At its last meeting, the Board discussed potential amendments to its Procedure Bylaw. Consensus did not appear to be achieved regarding electronic participation at Board and Committee meetings, so staff have drafted a bylaw to use as a starting point for further discussion. The highlighted areas are new/amended for the Board's ease of reference.

One item that was mentioned but that is not included in the draft, is whether the Board wishes to receive the agenda and therefore all of the items that are only for receipt at the same time. It was mentioned during the discussion at the last meeting, but it was not clear how the Board felt about it, so it has not been included. Should the Board wish to make the change, staff can amend the bylaw accordingly.
