Memorandum:

For the North Cariboo Joint Advisory Committee's consideration, please find the attached application to Northern Development Initiative Trust (NDIT) from the Cariboo Regional District in conjunction with the Parkland Recreation Commission. The request is for \$30,000 under the Community Places stream to support new trails at the popular Kosta's Cove site. The total project cost is \$45,000 with a \$15,000 contribution from the Cariboo Regional District.

Kosta's Cove is located at Ten Mile Lake and is included under subregional recreation services. This project has been identified as a goal in the 2022 North Cariboo Recreation and Parks Business Plan and part of the trail projects allocation in the financial plan.

Prior to forwarding the proposal to NDIT for Regional Advisory Committee (RAC) consideration, all Regional Development Account applications require a resolution of support from the local government with jurisdiction in the project.

Financial Implications:

This project has been identified in the North Cariboo Recreation Budget for 2022 with a \$15,000 financial contribution.

Policy Implications:

Discussion at the Regional District Board provided direction that NDIT applications for projects that fall under sub-regional recreation will be brought forward to the respective joint committee prior to going to the Regional District Board or City Council for ratification.
