### Memorandum:

On January 5, 2022 CRD Staff received a letter notifying the CRD of Nazko First Nation's intent to apply to the Federal Government to add the property containing the Three Nations Store and Lodge located in Nazko to their federal reserve lands. This is a lengthy process that if approved will ultimately remove the property from the jurisdiction of the CRD. In follow-up correspondence with Nazko First Nation staff, they are requesting a letter of support from the CRD.

CRD Staff anticipate minimal impact on the CRD should this application be approved by the Federal Government.

## **Financial Implications:**

Should the property be brought into federal reserve land, the property will no longer be subject to CRD and Cariboo-Chilcotin Regional Hospital District (CCRHD) tax requisitions. Any loss in tax requisition would be absorbed by the remainder of the properties paying into the applicable services. Total 2021 requisition for the property was \$798.03 to CRD services and \$362.36 to the CCRHD. Taxation impacts on properties are expected to be insignificant.
