#### **PURPOSE:**

To have a policy to set minimum lot sizes within the Cariboo Regional District.

# POLICY:

That all proposed lots associated with residential rezoning applications in areas not serviced by a community water or sewer system be required to have a minimum lot size of 0.4 hectares. However, in cases where:

- a lot was registered prior to the adoption of Cariboo Regional District Zoning Bylaw No. 1000 and the rezoning would be in keeping with the current use and size of a lot;
- 2. the rezoning represents:
- (a) a consolidation of two or more parcels to create less parcels than previously existed.

or

- (b) a minor boundary adjustment, provided no more lots could be created than existed at the time of the application;
- a proposed parcel of land is physically separated from its remainder by a highway right-of-way;

or

- 4. other special circumstances exist, as may become apparent from time to time;
- 5. all or part of a residential rezoning application may be exempted from the 0.4 hectare minimum lot size provision.
