PURPOSE:

To ensure building permits are in place for required areas within the Cariboo Regional District.

POLICY:

That the Cariboo Regional District Board require, as a condition of performance, that applicants for temporary commercial or industrial permits be required to take out a building permit within thirty calendar days of the date of issue of the temporary permit. Further, that work to the foundation stage must be completed before twenty-five percent of the duration of the temporary permit has expired. If either of these conditions are not adhered to, the Board may revoke the permit.
