That requests for fire protection area boundary amendments will be considered twice annually, in January and June of each year, in order to streamline and minimize the need to alter fire protection boundaries. Further, that non-contiguous boundary amendment requests will not be approved if approval from the private properties between the existing boundary and the requested inclusion can not be obtained.
