#### Memorandum:

Calibrate Assessments Ltd. was retained in 2021 to complete a housing needs assessment for the District of 100 Mile House and Electoral Areas G, H, and L to meet obligations under provincial legislation. The report contains a review of the four distinct communities within the region. The consultant, Calibrate Assessments Ltd., conducted an online survey and met with members of the community in 2021. The results of this community consultation are included in the report, along with analysis of data created by Statistics Canada, BC Stats, and BC Assessment. Recommendations were formed on how to react to challenges that were identified through the research.

The report is recommended for receipt as per Section 585.31 of the *Local Government Act*. Provincial legislation further requires that the local government consider the most recent housing needs report when developing an Official Community Plan (OCP), amending residential land use policies and designations, or when amending housing policies within an OCP. A subsequent report is required every five years from receipt of the first report. The report must be available publicly on the local government's website.
