For the South Cariboo Joint Committee's consideration, please find the attached application to Northern Development Initiative Trust (NDIT) from the 100 Mile House Curling Club. The request is for \$7,632 in grant funding under the Recreation Infrastructure Program to upgrade the water system and improve the curling rink ice at the South Cariboo Recreation Centre.

The total project cost is \$10,909.25 with a \$3,277.25 contribution from the club.

This item has been brought forward as information as the District of 100 Mile House is the local government of jurisdiction for this application and has taken the item to the April 12, 2022 Council Meeting for a resolution of support. In addition, the club would like a letter of support from the Cariboo Regional District.
