The Solid Waste Management Committee was last updated in November of 2021, since that time there have been seven Solid Waste Management Plan Advisory Committee (SWAC) meetings. Approved minutes from SWAC meetings are provided in the attachments. Two meetings were working group sub-committee meetings without minutes.

Meetings have included discussion of:

- MOECCS landfill criteria exemption requirements
- “Current Realities” for the region:
 - breakdown of how much waste is being received at each of the regional facilities (Quesnel, Williams Lake and 100 Mile House landfills)
 - distribution of waste received at controlled vs non controlled facilities
- Further details of the eight future options for consideration:
 - Diversion/Reuse Centers
 - Multi-unit Building Recycling
 - Commercial Recycling
 - Food Waste Reduction and Diversion
 - Landfill Disposal Bans
 - Upgrades to rural sites
 - User-Pay
 - New Curbside Garbage Collection
- Phase Two Public Consultation timing
