The number of birds captured was the highest season total since owl banding began at Tatlayoko Lake Bird Observatory (TLBO). Based on this success, the Tatlayoko Field Station Society (TFSS) has decided to make this pilot into a permanent extension of the banding season. The owl banding is a big hit within the Tatlayoko community with many families participating in the nightly sessions.
