Subject:	Pool Upgrade Public Consultation Process Update

## PURPOSE

The purpose of this report is to provide an update to the Committee regarding the Public Consultation Process for the Pool Upgrade Project.

## SUMMARY

- The public consultation process for the pool upgrade project has been active since May 13, 2022 and is scheduled to conclude on June 24.
- Participation via the online platform Let's Connect Quesnel has been very good to date with approximately 1.7k unique visitors accessing the site since the program was launched.
- 717 responses to the survey have been completed on line as of June 9, 2022.
  - $\circ$  50.5% of respondents are from CRD Areas A, B, C and I.
  - 48.4% of respondents are from the City of Quesnel.
- The majority of respondents have indicated that they are pool users (87.4%).
- The first public open house was held on Wednesday June 1 at the Arts and Recreation Centre. Approximately 29 people attended.
- Two additional public open houses are scheduled in June 2022:

0	Mon, June 13	École Red Bluff Lhtako Elementary	4 - 7 pm
0	Wed, June 15	Bouchie Lake Hall	4- 7 pm

- People who wish to participate in the survey but who do not have access or who prefer not to use the website, can complete a hard-copy version of the questionnaire. Surveys are available at City Hall, the Arts and Recreation Centre, the Quesnel CRD office, and at the public open houses.
- 43 hard copy surveys have been submitted as of June 9, 2022.
- A summary of the feedback received is expected to be presented to the Joint Advisory Committee at the September 13, 2022 meeting. The results will be posted on <u>letsconnectquesnel.ca/pool</u>
