Good morning, I am reaching out on behalf of the Quesnel Cattlemens Association. We have recently been made aware of the City of Quesnel's partnership plans to create a community forest. So far the beef sector has not been included in stakeholder engagement and when speaking with the coordinator at the City they informed me the stakeholder engagement process is just beginning. The proposed area map includes a large portion of range and agriculture land including ag lease and woodlots. The information does state this will not impact woodlot or private land but the boundary does include a lot of adjacent lease and range area in the CRD. I did not see anywhere that the CRD is looped in. So I am curious to learn a bit more about how the CRD can act as an advocate for the agricultural producers in this area who have for a long time been stewards of crown land and have held access to range lands for cattle grazing. It's interesting to me that the City is proposing to hold tenure on lands outside of city limits. Anyways, wondering if 1. the CRD is aware and 2. what involvement does the CRD have in the process moving forward? Any information would be really helpful and appreciated. Thank you ! Reanne
