Emergency Program Services staff were successful in their application to the UBCM 2022 Community Emergency Preparedness Fund (CEPF) under the Emergency Operations Centres (EOC) and Training. The CRD's project proposal for *EOC Training and Equipment Upgrades*, achieved \$10,663.29 in funding. In moving the project forward, staff have ordered four new laptops for the EOC and Incident Command System (ICS) 300 training for key personnel is scheduled for Fall 2022. Funding will be received after the final reporting process is complete.
