The Canadian Red Cross Society (CRCS) Wildfires 2017 fund has created a new opportunity for the Cariboo Regional District (CRD). The CRCS funding stream can support activities that aim to reduce disaster risks and raise awareness of disaster risks within the Cariboo Regional District. The initial proposal concept includes developing and implementing a short-term education program to promote fire and flood mitigation principles and to gain knowledge through conducting an environmental scan on how the public understands their flood and fire risks and to measure the reach of previous fire and flood mitigation activities in the region. Emergency Program Services staff propose to submit an application to CRCS to fund the environmental scan and public awareness campaign.
