# **Short Summary:**

NDIT Application – Kersley Playground 2023

#### Memorandum:

For the Cariboo Regional District Board's consideration, please find the attached application to Northern Development Initiative Trust (NDIT) from the Cariboo Regional District. The request is for \$30,000 in funding under the Community Places stream to support upgraded playground facilities at the Kersley Recreation Complex. The total cost is \$46,660 with a \$16,660 contribution from the Cariboo Regional District.

The Kersley Recreation Complex, which includes a covered natural ice arena and community hall, as well as a ball field, tennis court and surrounding greenspace is owned by the Cariboo Regional District and operated by the Kersley Recreation Commission/Community Association.

Prior to forwarding the proposal to NDIT for the Regional Advisory Committee's consideration, all Regional Development Account applications require a resolution of support from the local government with jurisdiction of the project.
