V•A•C

VACUUM ASSISTED CLOSURE OF WOUNDS

- VAC is a type of therapy to help wounds heal faster during treatment.
- VAC decreases air pressure on the wound which helps wounds to heal.
- VAC draws wound edges together and removes infectious materials.

HERE'S HOW V•A•C WORKS...

- The gauze dressing goes directly over the wound.
- An adhesive film covers and seals the dressing.
- A drainage tube leads from under the film and connects to the vacuum pump.
- V•A•C removes air pressure on the wound and removes harmful impurities from the wound.

V•A•C therapy provides an environment that promotes wound healing and is designed to help patients resume their activities of daily living while still receive proven wound healing benefits.
