When someone is buried (casket or ashes) we charge for the plot, the open and closing of the plot. Those monies are deposited in the Bank Account set up for the Cemetery. We use the money to purchase fuel for equipment, and other materials to help us maintain the site. All helpers along with us are community Volunteers.

Our specific goal is to continue to present a Beautiful Cemetery for the Lac La Hache Community. People to have a place to lay their loved ones to rest and to be able to come to visit their family/friends that are intermed there. There are some older graves that are sunken in and we would like to have those 'built' up. That would require us to purchase sod/soil, hiring equipment to lift up the stones and to fill in the sinking areas.

The Community of Lac La Hache. We have had a very busy year with interments. Young, older, newer residents and long time residents have been laid to rest. We offer a necessary service to the families.

1. Brief Description of Proposed Use of Grant Being Applied For:

There is some cedar fencing that keeps falling down and is an eyesore. We and our neighbor have only been able to do temporary 'fixes' Half of the Cemetery is fenced with chain link which stands up to the weather and the other half has the older wood fence. Previous years we were concentrating on acquiring lawn mowers, trimmers, and bringing in a C Can to secure the Cemetery assets. We have talked about the fencing problem for at least 4 years.

2. How do you know there is a need for this service/project in our community?

There is a definite need to continue having a Cemetery in Lac La Hache. This year alone we have had 8 interments and we know of another 4 before winter comes. The Cemetery is well used for services and people come up from time to time to visit their loved ones who are buried there.

We plan to start improving the fencing in the Spring as it will not be getting better especially after another winter. We will do what we can in the Spring. If we are not able to afford the new fencing we will try to 'shore' up the wood one the best we can. If we receive a lessor amount we could improved 'part' of the fence with chain link. Doing things as we can afford it would probably add to the material expenses that are continually costing more.

April 2023 or as soon as the snow is gone we can remove the old fencing board and prepare the ground for the new fencing Materials will be purchased. (we have a volunteer who has agreed to price out and purchase materials for the Cemetery) Once materials arrive there will be a date set for the Fencing Project. Depending on our funding we will hire a contractor or do all of this or help the volunteers get the fence up.

I'm sure that the feedback from everyone that goes up there will be positive. Currently we do hear from people about the falling down fence and we want to remedy that as soon as we can. A chain link fence staying up will be a great improvement.
