The Emergency Program Act (EPA) is currently being modernized to reflect the *UN Declaration* on the Rights of Indigenous People, the Declaration on the Rights of Indigenous Peoples Act, and the Draft Principles that Guide the Province's Relationship with Indigenous Peoples. The modernized EPA will also incorporate lessons learned from the COVID-19 pandemic, the unprecedented flood and wildfire seasons of 2017 and 2018, and all four phases of emergency management – mitigation, preparedness, response, and recovery.
