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NDIT Application – Lone Butte Willowford School 2023

Memorandum:

For the Cariboo Regional District Board's consideration, please find the attached application to Northern Development Initiative Trust (NDIT) from the Lone Butte Historical Society. The request is for \$30,000 in funding under the Community Places stream to support moving the 1930's Willowford school and creating a gathering place in the centre of Lone Butte. This is a part of a \$48,000 project with a \$15,000 contribution from the South Cariboo Economic Development Budget, and a \$2,000 cash contribution and \$1,000 in-kind contribution from the Lone Butte Historical Society.

The project consists of moving the Willowford school from Horse Lake Road to the centre of Lone Butte. The school will be relocated to the centre of Lone Butte on a property with the historic Alice Singleton house, which once housed the Red Cross Outpost, and the original Diefenbunker. These structures all house artifacts and act as a museum showcasing the history of Lone Butte. The funding will also be used to landscape the property and create a gathering space for community events and tourists. This project aligns with goals in the 2023 South Cariboo Economic Development Business Plan including support improvements to Lone Butte heritage sites to build tourism assets along Highway 24.

Prior to forwarding the proposal to NDIT for the Regional Advisory Committee's consideration, all Regional Development Account applications require a resolution of support from the local government with jurisdiction.
