- complete a survey on the eight new services/changes identified by the Solid Waste Advisory Committee.

- 7. Pine Valley
- 8. Commodore Crescent
- 9. Fox Mountain
- 10. North Lake Side/Lexington

- 11. South Lake Side
- 12. Esler
- 13. Dog Creek
- 14. Flett Subdivision
- 15. 103 Mile
- 16. 105 Mile
- 17. Buffalo/Gateway
- 18. Ranchettes/Horse Lake/Lone Butte
- 19. 93 Mile
