On behalf of the 100 Mile House Curling Club, I would like to thank you for your continued support. We have had a return of sorts to a better than normal participation in the 100 Mile Curling Club. This resurgence is a testament to the need within the community of 100 Mile House and the surrounding area for the sport of curling. (Please find attached the membership summary for your information).

We have had issues with the facility in the past. With the addition of the reverse osmosis and water softening system, and the tankless hot water system in the kitchen, we have greatly improved the league and bonspiel curling experience.

We wanted to express our appreciation to Darron Campbell CRD and Josh Dickerson Canlan for the tankless hot water system specifically as it had a very positive impact on the tedious task of cleaning up after serving approx. 80 people at a bonspiel.

Year after year, because of our volunteer participation, we have a low cost of operating. We are able to break even which translates into a lower cost

for our members. (Please find attached the 15-year capital plan for your information). Just the fact that we have a 15-year plan indicates our commitment to the sport and the facility. There are some improvements to the facility that we need which have been identified to Josh at Canlan. It is our hope that the CRD can find the funds to make these improvements and again show their commitment to the community and our club.

We are forever grateful for the reasonable lease rate, and just the fact that we know we have the support of Josh and Darron is a comfort that translates into a large group of members who gladly volunteer their time for something they perceive as a very worthwhile endeavor. Not many curling clubs have that.

Our investment of approx. \$15,000 in the water purification system resulted in a very positive curling experience and we expect that to translate into even more community participation in the sport of curling in the future. We were able to provide a full slate of Bonspiels which resulted in a social connection that we have not experienced in a number of years. It was great to see and experience.

With a large volunteer membership, and after a super positive curling experience, we head into the next season with a mountain of optimism. Thank you for the part you played in this great experience.

Capital Purchases and Improvements

We invested a lot of money in a reverse osmosis system and water softener which made an incredible improvement to our ice conditions. We still have issues with humidity control, and the existing concrete slab such as exposed rebar and settling out of level and we hope these issues can be addressed by Canlan and the CRD before the next curling season.

Canlan and the CRD replaced our inadequate hot water tank in the kitchen with a tankless hot water system which greatly improved the clean up tasks and it was very much appreciated.
