Re: Wells-Barkerville Community Forest expansion

The Ministry of Forests has invited the community of Wells to apply to manage some additional areas of Crown land as part of the Wells-Barkerville Community Forest (K3R).

We propose to add two areas of land: "Rucheon" and "Lower Matthew".

Rucheon is approximately 2225 hectares of land about 20 km west of Wells and is situated between the north side of Rucheon Creek and the south side of Willow River.

Lower Matthew is approximately 1860 hectares approximately 50 kilometers east of Wells and is situated on the south side of the Matthew River and east side of the Cariboo River.

A map of each of the two areas is enclosed. A third map is an overview showing both areas and the existing Wells-Barkerville Community Forest.

If approved, Wells-Barkerville Community Forest would have the exclusive logging rights within the community forest, but the lands would remain open to the public. Trappers, guide-outfitters and miners would retain their tenures and licences.

Wells-Barkerville Community Forest is currently among the smallest of the 60 community forests in the province. Even with the proposed addition of two areas of land it would still be among the smallest.

Significant attributes of Rucheon and Lower Matthew are identified in the table below.
