- A Host hotel has been chosen and the announcement is pending.
- The 1st installment of funding has been received \$300,000
- Looking at potentially borrowing Vernon's dry floor for the West Fraser Centre, for the opening ceremonies

Through Committee questions:

- It was proposed that the option of utilizing First responders from Cariboo Regional Distict Fire Departments be investigated.
- President Balkwill will coordinate with Staff when another update to the Committee is appropriate.

2. Cariboo Ski Touring Club - Brian Balkwill and Brian Kennelly

Update to the Delegation's power point presentation: Mr. Kennelly advised that since publishing the Agenda, the Club has now received approval from B.C. Recreation Sites & Trails to update and improve the biathalon range which is located on grazing pasture.

The Cariboo Ski Touring Club attended Council requesting a letter of support for funding application(s) to improve their outdated biathlon range before the 2024 BC Winter Games in Quesnel. CSTC will forward a letter to Quesnel City Council and to the Cariboo Regional District to officially request support from both organizations.

The Biathlon range was constructed in late 1997 and began operation in 1998, to host the 2000 BC Winter Games. The range is now very outdated and in need of an upgrade to host the 2024 BC Winter Games.
