- 1. Meeting called to order: 10:08 AM by Committee Chair John Massier

- 4. Driving Tour Brochure Update
 - a. N. Whitehead due to short staffing, brochure will be ready by end of May then off to the printers.
 - b. Discussion regarding distribution and tracking:
 - i. Key drop off locations
 - ii. N. Whitehead has concerns with the committee taking on too much with distribution logistics.
 - iii. Suggestion to deliver beyond CRD such as Cache Creek, Lillooet "Gateway locations"
 - iv. N. Whitehead to email group when the brochures are ready.
- 5. Regional Heritage Network Meeting Planning
 - a. Committee agreed that the initial meeting was very successful.
 - b. E. Hunter committed to host another meeting in Fall 2023
 - c. B. Rutherford suggested a grant writing workshop as part of the next meeting.
 - d. N. Whitehead suggested possible other locations for future meetings.
 - e. The committee discussed the importance of grant applications and the grant writing assistance provided by the CRD Economic Development Department.
- 6. Statement of Significance (SOS) discussion.
 - a. Beaver Pass House: J. Massier was out to the site. Flooding is currently occurring on the site. MoTI working on keeping highway safe and open.
 - Interior Health Nursing Station Alexis Creek Update: B. Rutherford got the contact for IHA Land Manager but no response. B. Rutherford found a previous draft of the SoS and provided to N. Whitehead.
 - c. Lone Butte B. Rutherford received email from local MP that CN would not be supportive of designation. Committee agreed to continue lobbying effort over the long-term, but remove site from short-list for SoS workshop.
 - d. Big Lake NW enquired with CRD library staff as to whether historical materials are at library, either Big Lake or CRD Williams Lake archives. Staff are looking into it.

7. Action Tracking Updates

- a. Committee reviewed and updated the tracking table.
- b. J. Massier Suggested a tour of Lone Butte Water Tower for the committee's annual tour. Ask CN to attend our tour.
- c. B. Rutherford Had a discussion with Amy Thacker at CCTA to consider the purpose and location of signage. There are generally four types of highway signage: RSTBC, BC Parks, MOTI and City Local Signs. MOTI will ask for volume of traffic as part of their approval process. Destination BC signs for tourism must align with their standards. Summary of discussion was to focus on site interpretive signs before highway signs.
- d. B. Rutherford Outdoor Rec Council has \$10 million for signage and trail maintenance.
