Short Summary:

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Likely Community Hall Community Works Funding (CWF) Moisture Barrier Project and Enabling Agreement

Voting:

Corporate Vote – Weighted

Memorandum:

A request for up to \$5,000 of Community Works Funding was received from the Likely & District Chamber of Commerce for the placement of Visqueen vapour protection over the dirt in the crawl space underneath the main area of Likely Community Hall to act as a moisture barrier.

It is expected that the moisture barrier will reduce heat loss through the building envelope and increase the efficiency of the building.

Because the community hall is not owned by the Regional District, a contribution agreement between the Regional District and the Likely & District Chamber of Commerce is required for this project by UBCM under its Gas Tax Sharing Master Agreement with the federal government.

Under the terms of the agreement, the community group is responsible for managing the project, maintaining financial records, reporting on measurable results and retaining ownership of the asset for a minimum of 10 years.

Financial Implications:

The proposal from the Likely & District Chamber of Commerce requests up to \$5,000 from the Community Hall Improvements envelope of the 2023 CWF program.

The Board approved the CWF funding schedule for 2023, including the Community Hall Energy Efficiency and Water Conservation Improvements envelope which originally had a total of \$150,000 available. If this request from the Likely & District Chamber of Commerce is approved, \$5,000 will be committed through the Community Hall Improvements envelope, leaving a balance of \$117,500 available for community hall projects.

Policy Implications:

None. The Board approved the CWF funding schedule for 2023, including the Community Hall Energy Efficiency and Water Conservation Improvements envelope.
