### **Memorandum:**

At the September 7, 2023, Committee of the Whole meeting it was requested that staff:

Bring forward a chart of Community Works Fund expenditures for the last several years grouped by region (North, Central, South).

The following table and charts are brought forward for the Board's information. Community Works Funds have been tracked several different ways over the years. The data used is a combination of several tracking systems standardized and combined to provide a record of all CWF expenses dating back from 2006 to present.

While the request was for a distinction between the North, Central and South, a category identifying projects as "Cariboo" has been added. Projects in this category do not lend themselves to geographic distinction. An example is Rural Refuse. A lot of CWF's have gone to this service over the years and been directed to facilities throughout the Regional District. Similarly, CWF's used for Regional District properties such as the libraries and offices have been included in this category also.
