1. Brief Description of Proposed Use of Grant Being Applied For: The grant in 2023 was requested for amount of 3000.00. We received 1500.00 from CRD and 1500.00 from the City of 100 Mile House. Requesting the same. The grant will assist in general costs of the show such as cost of website, administration costs, costs of event set up and take down. Plaques/awards etc.

Last year, as well as past years the event has brought in hundreds of out of town vehicles for a minimum of 3 days. Many staying a week or 2 before or after the event. In addition, the event brings in 100's of spectators to the area. The economic impact to our local businesses, hotels, gas stations, restaurants, local stores is substantial. Even though the community is coming back from the downfalls of the last few years, it still needs a boost to assist with the local economy.

4. Describe the key activities and timelines to complete this project: The work on this event will start as early as November 2023 and will continue until after July 19 to 21, 2024's event. 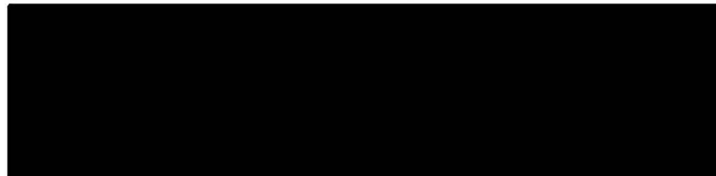

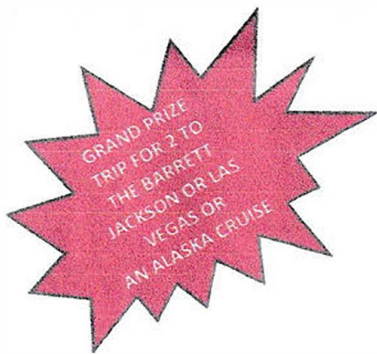

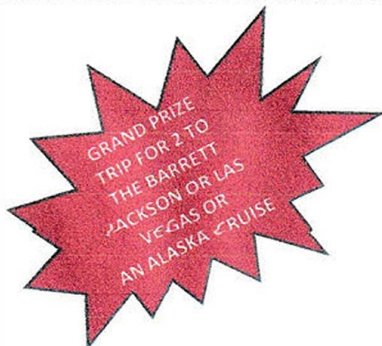
