Society Act

100 Mile Model Flyers Society

Constitution

- The name of this Society shall be the 100 Mile Model flyers Society.
- 2. The purposes of the Society are
 - a) to promote and develop radio controlled model aircraft in the 100 Mile House area;
 - b) to develop quality model aircraft flying facility(s) lending itself to a family oriented atmosphere;
 - c) to develop and implement education and training programs;
 - d) to participate and contribute to community activities.
- The operations of the Society shall be chiefly carried out in the vicinity of 100 Mile House, British Columbia. This clause is alterable.
- 4. This Society shall be affiliated with the MODEL AERONAUTICS ASSOCIATION OF CANADA and is a charter member of said organization, herein after referred to as MAAC. This clause is alterable.
- On winding up, or dissolution of this Society, all assets remaining after all debts have been paid, shall be transferred to a non-profit organization with objectives similar to those of this Society. This clause is unalterable.
