PROJECT INFORMATION

1. Brief Description of Proposed Use of Grant Being Applied For:

We are applying to help fund our Halloween activities. Trunk or treating is great fun for the entire community. We have a number of members of the community that decorate their trunks or trailers and park them at the hall, they hand out candy to the children that trunk or treat, we also have candy bags, hot coffee, hot chocolate, and hot dogs that we hand out to all attendees for free. At the end of the night we have a wonderful fireworks display safely deployed by the local volunteer firefighters.

2. How do you know there is a need for this service/project in our community?

With our area being as rural as it is traditional, trick or treating is not really a possibility. And driving all our children to town can be a burden, and not as much for the children, this event has an average attendance of 200-300 people. 150-200 of these are children under 12. This lets us know that it is appreciated and we feel it is well attended.

3. Start date of the project: 10/22/2024 End date for the project: 11/1/2024

4. Describe the key activities and timelines to complete this project: This is an event that takes about 3 weeks of planning and organizing to all be executed on Halloween night with clean up all completed before our volunteers go home. We must secure the firefighters, fireworks, and food/treats. Volunteers put together the treat bags that week, and the hall must be opened up that day to cook all the hot dogs and place them in buns and warmers. Coffee, and hot chocolate must be prepared and hot before guests arrive.

5. How will you determine if the project/event was successful? We determine success by the number of attendees, especially the amount of trick or treaters that we serve.

6. Does your organization have sustainable funding? Please explain. We rely mostly on grants from the CRD, rentals of the hall, and donations from the community. The rentals are mostly small user groups (OUT, yoga, Volleyball), community activities (belly dancing, dance lessons), birthday parties, and celebrations of life, we also do a few weddings.

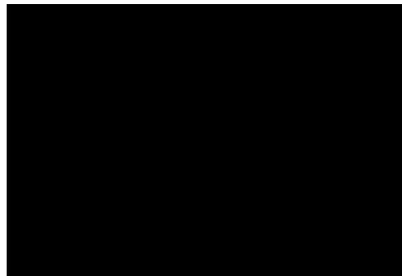
