Memorandum:

The Board identified its desire to improve how it communicates and engages with the public as part of its 2023 - 2026 Strategic Plan. Staff have drafted an Engagement Strategy based on Board feedback, organizational observations, and public engagement training and practices. The strategy presented identifies key roles and responsibilities for Board members and staff, identifies three phases of planned activities, and identifies high level resource requirements.

The 2024 business plan for the communications department includes funding for planned activities under Phase 1 of the strategy. Notably, this strategy will require an increase in resources to the communications department, which is experiencing a shortage of staff due to an ongoing and difficult to fill vacancy in a part-time position. As such, this strategy should be considered in light of any decision making during the budget-finance committee meeting.
