## **Short Summary:**

Big Lake Community Hall Community Works Funding (CWF) new insulated doors project and enabling agreement.

#### **Voting:**

Corporate Vote - Weighted

#### Memorandum:

The Big Lake Community Association has requested a Community Works Funding grant of up to \$9,500 to install new energy efficient doors at the Big Lake Community Hall.

The new doors will replace the approximately 40-year-old doors which have an R value of 2.5 to 3 and are leading to heat loss. The new doors will have an R value of 6 and will include new trim and insulation.

Because the facility is not owned by the CRD, a contribution agreement between the Regional District and the Big Lake Community Association is required for this project by UBCM under its Gas Tax Sharing Master Agreement with the federal government.

Under the terms of the agreement, the community group is responsible for managing the project, maintaining financial records, reporting on measurable results, and retaining ownership of the asset for a minimum of 10 years.

# **Financial Implications:**

The proposal from the Big Lake Community Association requests up to \$9,500 from the Community Hall Energy Efficiency and Water Conservation Improvements envelope of the 2024 CWF program.

In 2024,\$150,000 has been allocated for the Community Hall Energy Efficiency and Water Conservation Improvements envelope. If this request from the Big Lake Community Association is approved, \$9,500 will be committed through the Community Hall Improvements envelope, leaving a balance of \$140,500 available for community hall projects in 2024.

## **Policy Implications:**

None. The Board approved the CWF funding schedule for 2024, including the Community Hall Energy Efficiency and Water Conservation Improvements envelope.
