# **Short Summary:**

NDIT Application - Cariboo Elders Society Seniors Park Upgrade

## Memorandum:

For the Cariboo Regional District Board's consideration, please find an application to the Northern Development Initiative Trust (NDIT) from the Cariboo Elders Building & Recreational Society. The request is for \$11,493 for park upgrades, including electrical service panel, proper lighting installation and washroom renovations.

The park is a recreational gathering place for seniors in the community and a revenue source for the Creekside Seniors Centre in 100 Mile House. Funding support for the project, which has a total value of \$16,493, is anticipated to come from Northern Development and the South Cariboo Community Enhancement Foundation.

Prior to forwarding the application to NDIT for the Regional Advisory Committee's consideration, all Regional Development Account applications require a resolution of support from the local government within the district.
