## **Short Summary:**

NDIT Application – Esler Disc Golf Course

#### Memorandum:

For the Cariboo Regional District Board's consideration, please find attached an application to the Northern Development Initiative Trust (NDIT) from the Cariboo Disc Golf Club. The request is for \$27,944 in funding under the Community Places stream to install a tournament grade disc golf course at the Esler Sports Complex in Williams Lake.

This application is for signage and tee box installation to advance and promote the sport of disc golf in Williams Lake and surrounding area. Funding support for the project, which has a total value of \$47,944 is planned to come from Northern Development, the Cariboo Regional District through the Central Cariboo Recreation budget and the Williams Lake Community Forest.

Prior to forwarding the application to NDIT for the Regional Advisory Committee's consideration, all Regional Development Account applications require a resolution of support from the local government within the jurisdiction.
