Should we receive any complaints (for specific, legislated reasons), it will be necessary to appoint a minimum of three members to Parcel Tax Roll Review Panels to hear the complaint(s). In the interest of time, it would be prudent for the Board to appoint the panels at this time in case they are needed. Staff's recommendation is to appoint the members of each rural caucus so that there will be a panel available in each sub-region.
