Short Summary:

Central Cariboo Victim Services Renewal Agreement (2023-2025) with the City of Williams Lake

Memorandum:

The Cariboo Regional District has a long-standing contribution agreement with the City of Williams Lake for delivery of police-based victim services through the Williams Lake RCMP detachment to the benefit of residents across the Central Cariboo including electoral areas D, E, F, J and K. The current three-year agreement for this arrangement expired at the end of December 2022.

A proposed renewal of the agreement is attached, which includes a contribution of \$24,500 in 2023 and an increase to \$26,000 in 2025 and 2026. The expired three-year agreement had a payment of \$24,500 annually.

The 2022 annual report for victim services supplied by the City is also attached for reference and includes a support funding summary of \$24,500 from the Regional District, \$36,575 from the City and \$72,129 from the Province through the Ministry of Public Safety and the Solicitor General.

City staff have advised that the budget for 2023 was increased including \$24,500 from the Regional District, approximately \$46,000 from the City and \$83,036 from the Province.

The report notes 603 clients were served in 2022. The activities report for 2023 is pending.

The scope of services in the proposed renewal agreement are not materially different from the current agreement and no additional services have been included.

Financial Implications:

The cost of the contribution agreement is allocated to the Central Cariboo Victim Services function and the increase of \$1,500 per year to an annual payment of \$26,000 can be accommodated with no increase to the current taxation level.
