### Memorandum:

For the Cariboo Regional District Board's consideration, please find attached an application to the Northern Development Initiative Trust (NDIT) from the Williams Lake Cycling Club. The request is for \$30,000 in funding under the Community Places stream to refurbish an existing trail in an existing network, including excavation work.

Funding support for this project, which has a total value of \$50,820 is anticipated to come from Northern Development Initiative Trust (\$30,000), the Cariboo Regional District/City of Williams Lake (\$20,000) and the Williams Lake Cycling Club (\$820).

Prior to forwarding the application to NDIT for the Regional Advisory Committee's consideration, all Regional Development Account applications require a resolution of support from the local government within the jurisdiction.
