For the Cariboo Regional District Board's consideration, please find the attached sponsorship request from the Lhtako Dene Nation to support their pow wow taking place August 2-4, 2024. The event will celebrate the traditions and culture of the Lhtako Dene as well as recognize the 50th anniversary of the Quesnel Tillicum Society. These events continue to build on past success and showcase talented dancers and drummers from across the country. Events are open to the public and everyone is encouraged to experience the richness and diversity of pow wow culture.

In April 2024, the Cariboo Regional District Board of Directors also agreed to sponsor the Williams Lake First Nation's Father's Day and 3rd Annual Speaking Our Truth pow wows with a \$5,500 contribution from the COVID-19 Smart Restart Funds allocated to First Nations reconciliation at the June 23, 2023, Cariboo Regional District Board Meeting.
