Director Forseth has submitted the following request:

For the last number of months, I've had some constituents express concerns about the former McLeese Lake Elementary school site and especially around the school being accidentally lit on fire as well as the fact that people have already been rummaging through the building and may not be aware of the risk to their personal health as there is asbestos throughout the school site.

School District #27 advises that a letter of support from myself as the local area director for McLeese Lake would be helpful in securing the funding from the Ministry of Education for this specific project.

I would certainly draft a letter myself but want to put it on official regional district letterhead and there is a bit of time sensitivity to this as SD27 has already submitted their major capital project list for 25/26 and the letter of support in favour of their major capital list for the demolition project at McLeese Lake may get them over the finish line and get to a yes.
