Short Summary:

Budget Amendment for Interlakes VFD Tender Purchase

Voting:

Corporate Vote - Weighted

Memorandum:

A budget amendment is required for the purchase of the new Interlakes VFD Tender. When initially budgeted, the timing of the delivery and payment for the tender was based on the historical waiting period between order and delivery. As such, the tender was anticipated to arrive in early 2025. As payment is due upon delivery, financing through the Municipal Finance Authority was also planned to occur in 2025.

The tender has now been delivered to the Interlakes VFD and must be paid for. An amended budget has been created reflecting the purchase of the apparatus in 2024 and the financing and subsequent loan payments commencing in 2024, and is presented here for the Board's consideration.

Financial Implications:

It is planned that financing will be arranged in September with loan payments beginning in October. The financing will offset the purchase of the apparatus so the only impact on the budget will be the additional loan payments not in the budget. Three months of loan payments will result in an additional cost of \$17,695 and be paid from operating surplus.
