The evaluation and success of these project items will be directly measured by a increase in 100 Mile Model Flyers membership and guest site visitors. As well as the volume of requests to participate in a ever growing amount of community events.

We are primarily funded by our club membership fees. As membership fluctuates each year we do charge a fee for Fun Fly Events: entry fee, meals to purchase and overnight camping fee. We also refurbish used model planes and sell them to interested parties.
