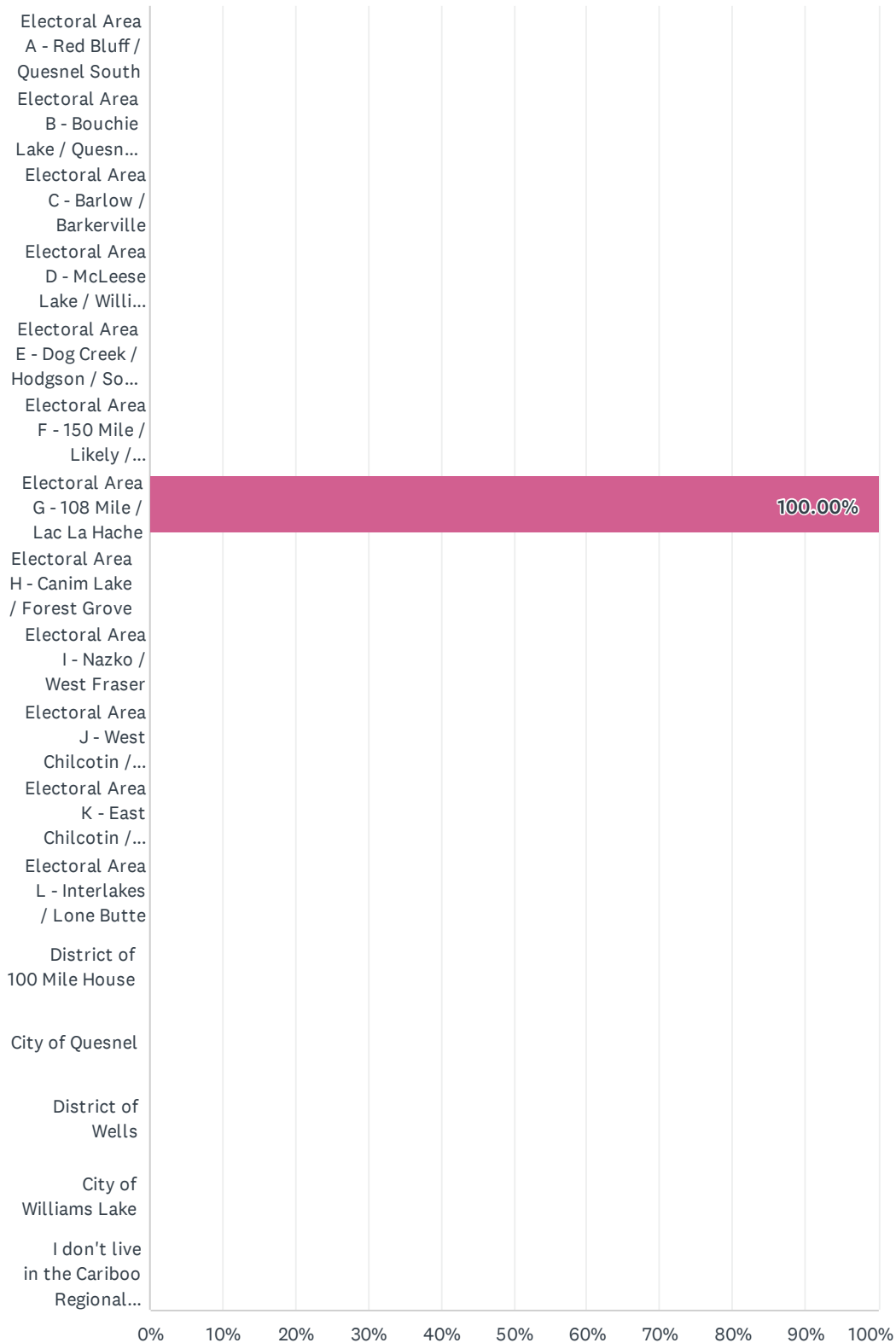


Q1 Which Electoral Area / Municipality do you live in?

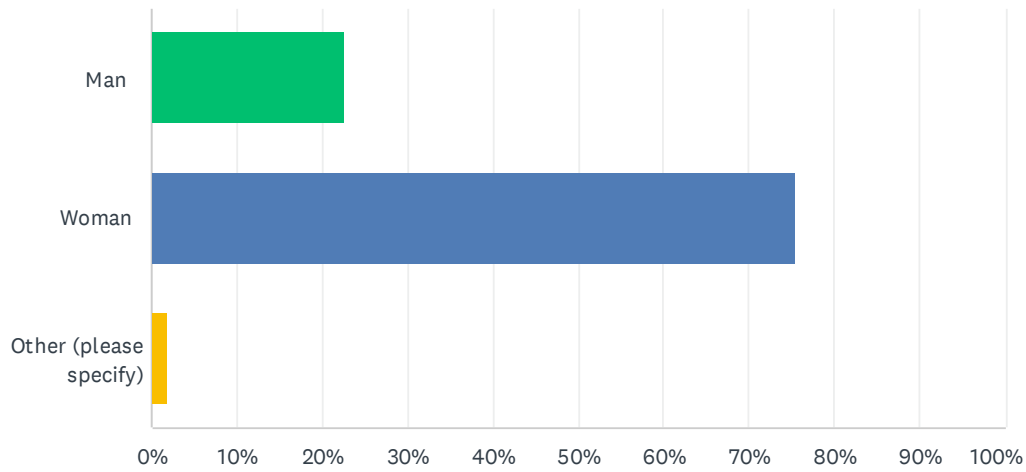

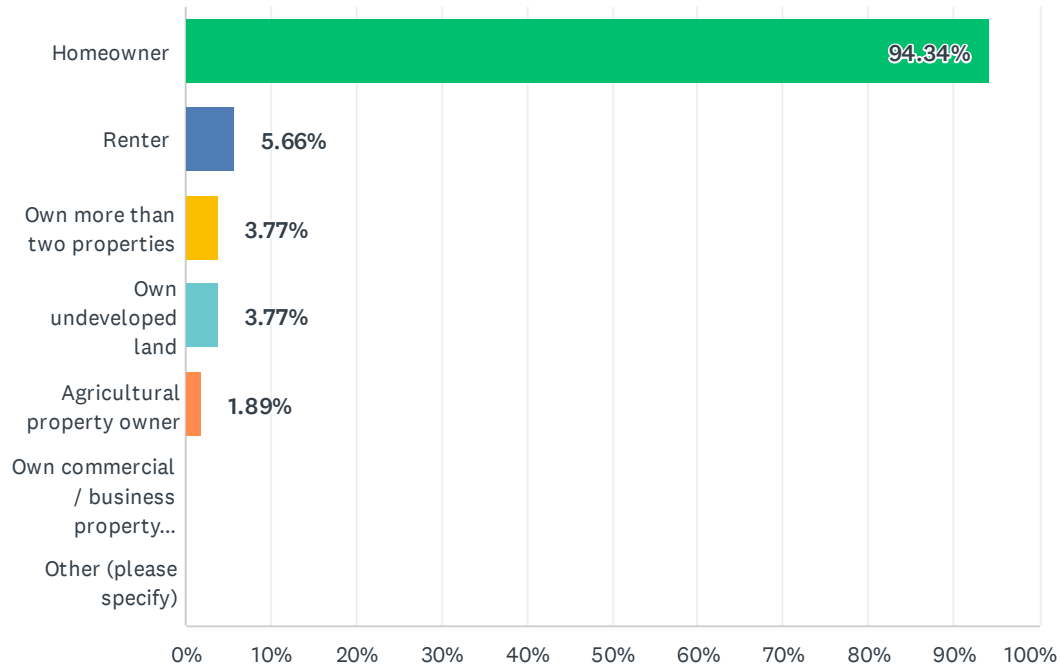

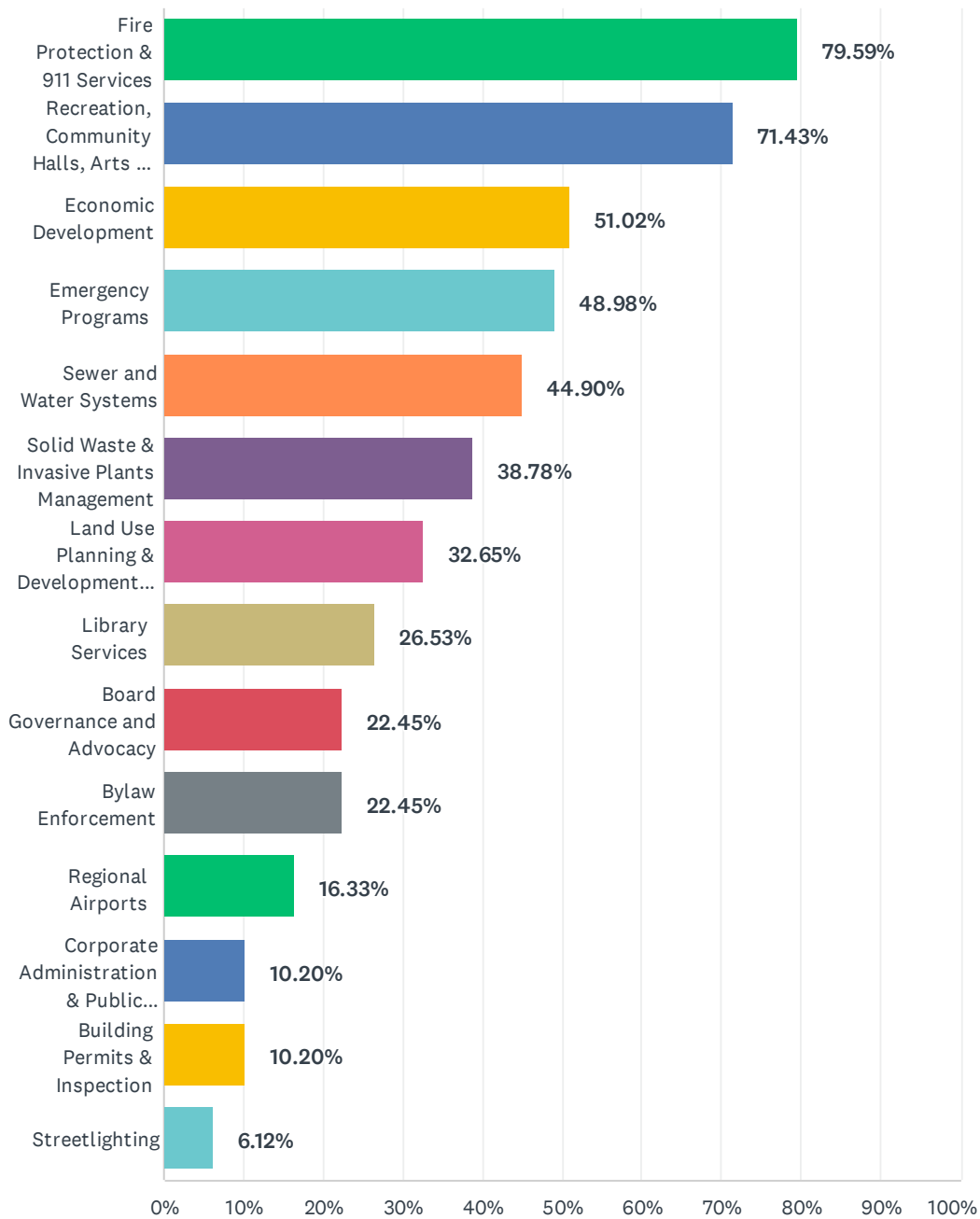

Q5 Please select the five most important regional district services for you.

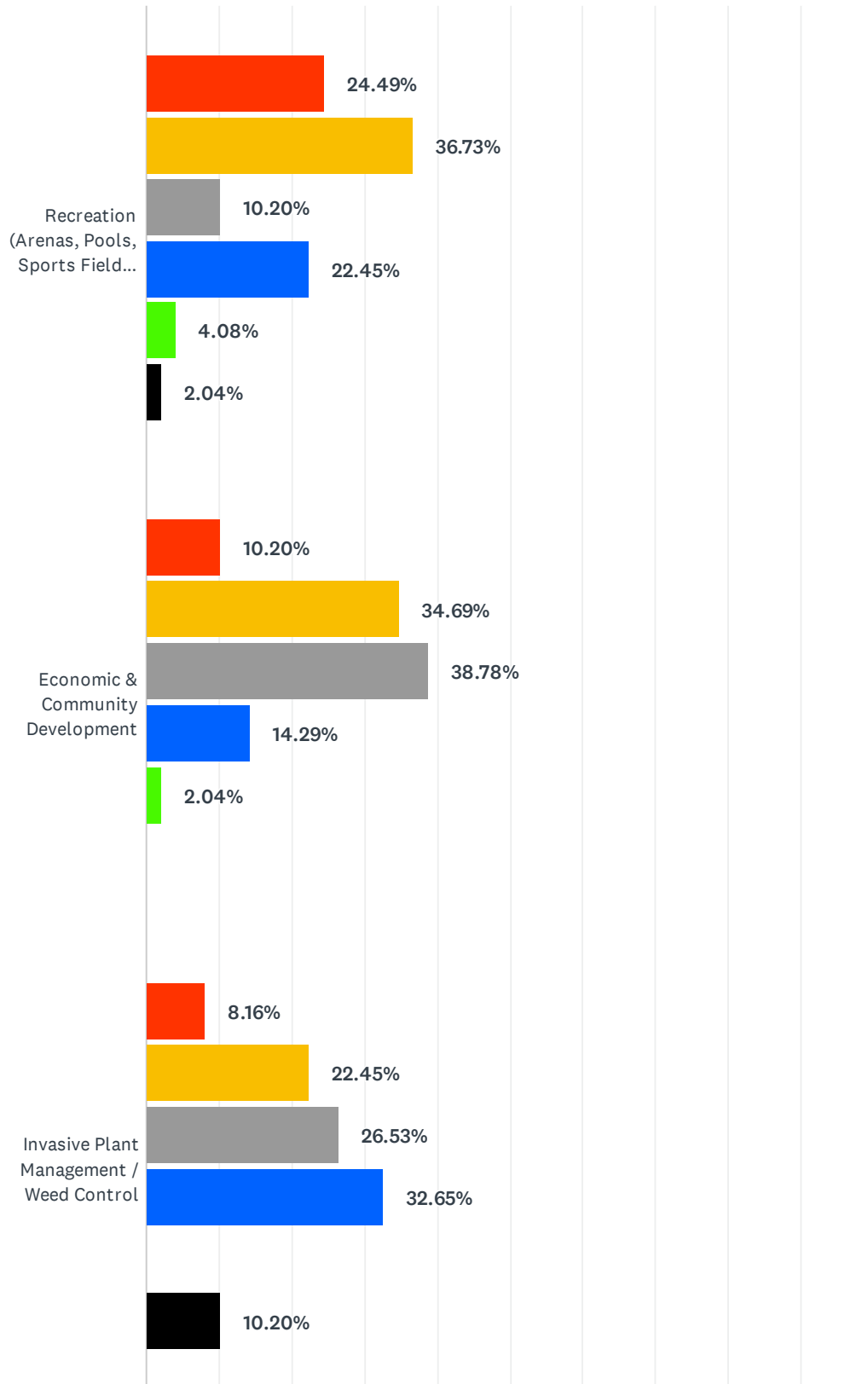
