At its May 23, 2025 meeting the Board directed staff to submit a UBMC meeting request with Ministry of Transportation and Transit staff, to discuss the following topics:

- Radio Range Road maintenance (joint meeting with City of Williams Lake)
- Highway 97 maintenance
- Active Transportation Routes clarity on Regional District's responsibility
- School zone speed limit in Area C and other rural areas
- Road closures and their impacts on services. Specifically recent Durrell Road closure impact on Fire Services.
