# **Short Summary:**

Tatla Lake Community Hall additional Community Works Funding (CWF) for solar panels project

# **Voting:**

Corporate Vote - Weighted

#### Memorandum:

In October 2024, the Tatla Lake Area Community Association requested up to \$28,000 in Community Works Funding to support a \$53,000 solar panel installation project at the Tatla Lake Community Hall.

At its meeting on October 18, 2024, the Cariboo Regional District Board of Directors passed a resolution to allocate up to \$28,000 from the 2024 Community Hall Energy Efficiency and Water Conservation envelope of the Community Works Fund for the solar panel project. A contribution agreement was then entered into with the community group to provide the funding.

The remaining project cost was expected to be covered by a \$25,000 BC Hydro rebate.

However, due to BC Hydro's rebate calculation method, which is based on the size of the solar panel system, the Association received \$16,000 rather than the anticipated \$25,000. Therefore, an additional \$9,000 in Community Works Fund support is requested to meet the total project cost of \$53,000.

# **Financial Implications:**

The proposal from the Tatla Lake Area Community Association requests \$9,000 from the Community Hall Energy Efficiency and Water Conservation envelope of the 2025 CWF program. The Board approved the CWF funding schedule for 2025, including the Community Hall Energy Efficiency and Water Conservation envelope which has a total of \$150,000 available. If this

application from the Tatla Lake Area Community Association is approved, \$9,000 will be committed leaving a balance of \$131,000 available for other eligible community hall projects.

### **Policy Implications:**

None. The Board approved the CWF funding schedule for 2025, including the Community Hall Energy Efficiency and Water Conservation envelope.
