Short Summary:

Horse Lake Water System Loan Authorization Bylaw No. 5511, 2025

Voting:

Corporate Vote - Weighted

Memorandum:

The Horse Lake System is currently on an indefinite Water Quality Advisory due to high levels of manganese in the source water. This greenfield upgrade (treatment plant) to the system will remedy this issue and provide a template for other small systems dealing with similar issues in the CRD.

Loan Authorization Bylaw No. 5511 is presented for consideration of three readings so that it may be forwarded to the Ministry of Housing and Municipal Affairs for statutory approval, prior to the Board authorizing a public approval process.

Staff's strong recommendation will be to proceed to an Alternative Approval Process (AAP) rather than referendum, as the costs are significantly less.

Financial Implications:

The Alternate Approval Process that will be requested is to fund 25% of the project by the residents using the system, as directed by the Board. The remaining 75% would come from the Community Works Fund. Total cost is estimated to be 1.2 million dollars as of 2025.
