BYLAW NO. 5511

A bylaw of the Cariboo Regional District, in the Province of British Columbia, to authorize the borrowing of the estimated cost of capital equipment for improvements to the Horse Lake Water System.

The Board of the Cariboo Regional District in open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:

1. The Regional Board is hereby empowered and authorized to undertake and carry out or cause to be carried out improvements to the Horse Lake Water System Service to residents in a portion of the community of Horse Lake, located in Electoral Area L of the Cariboo Regional District, and to do all things necessary in connection therewith and without limiting the generality of the foregoing:
 - a) To borrow upon the credit of the Regional District a sum not exceeding one hundred seventy-five thousand dollars (\$175,000).
 - b) To acquire all such real property, easements, rights-of-way, licenses, rights or authorities as may be requisite or desirable for or in connection with the improvement of said water system service.
2. The maximum term for which debentures may be issued to secure the debt created by this bylaw is ten (10) years.
3. This bylaw may be cited as "Horse Lake Water System Loan Authorization Bylaw No. 5511, 2025."
