The grant funding would be used re-stock our soup kitchen with dinner plates and bowls. What we have been using in the kitchen has been dwindling over the last 40 years (breakage, theft, wear and tear) and has gotten to the point where we are unable to continue to host our several community dinners that are held annually. (Christmas dinner, Thanksgiving dinner, Easter dinner, Volunteer Appreciation dinner, etc). They will also be used for our daily breakfast and lunch programs. We are hoping to buy some good-quality, strong, safe dinnerware that will last us potentially for the next few decades moving forward.

Our kitchen serves over 20,000 breakfasts and lunches per year, in addition to the 4-6 community dinner events that are held yearly. For example, during our 2024 Christmas dinner, we served 419 adults and 312 children.

We wish to order and purchase enough equipment for the kitchen to begin using it as soon as our Thanksgiving 2026 dinner.
