March 9 calls with total of 9hrs 45 mins of man hours with an average of 2 members per call

April 4 calls with total of 2hrs 20 min of man hours with an average of 3 members per call

May 3 calls with total of 32 min of man hours with average of 2 members per call

June 6 calls with total of 6hrs 19 min of man hours with average of 6 members per call

July 6 calls with total of 9hrs 2min of man hours with average of 3 members per call

August 6 calls with total of 5hrs 5mins of man hours with an average of 2 members per call

September 9 calls with total of 10hrs 5mins of man hours with average of 2 members per call

October 2 calls with total of 1hr 18 min of man hours with average of 2 members per call

November 5 calls with total 1hr 43 min of man hours with average of 2 member per call

December 10 calls with total 7hrs 2 min of man hours with average of 2 members per call
