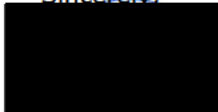
Dear Al Richmond:

Thank you for your letter regarding the Cariboo Memorial Hospital (CMH) construction impacting surrounding street parking. Interior Health advised Graham Construction leadership of the concerns early in December. Graham leadership confirmed that they include offsite parking and respect of neighbours as part of their orientation of all trades staff working on the project. Graham leadership advised they were supportive of ticketing and towing improperly parked vehicles on adjacent streets as they have advised their trades staff and Graham expects their adherence to bylaws and respect for CMH neighbours.

There is a plan this spring for Graham to reduce the footprint of their laydown area on site, which will create about 25 more parking stalls, and once the CMH Redevelopment project is complete, there will be a total increase of 60 stalls on site.

I am concerned about any matters where our staff or contractors are disrespectful of our neighbours. Without signs restricting street parking, it does make it difficult to also message not to use the adjacent streets for parking. If the city were to impose parking restrictions around CMH, we can commit to reinforcing our expectations of compliance with this as well.
